

The king has a hut on the hill.


The king has lots of sheep and pigs.

The king can sing.


The king sings to the sheep, the pigs and the men.

Jack sings too. He is glad to have a king.






The bad men will soon be back. It will not be long.

We must get rid of the dragon!



Jack shoots.


Bill has a net.
