Sam. “I can see a crab.”

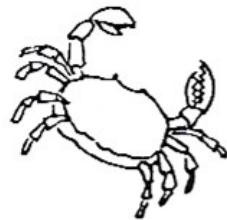
spade deep rock-pool

far.

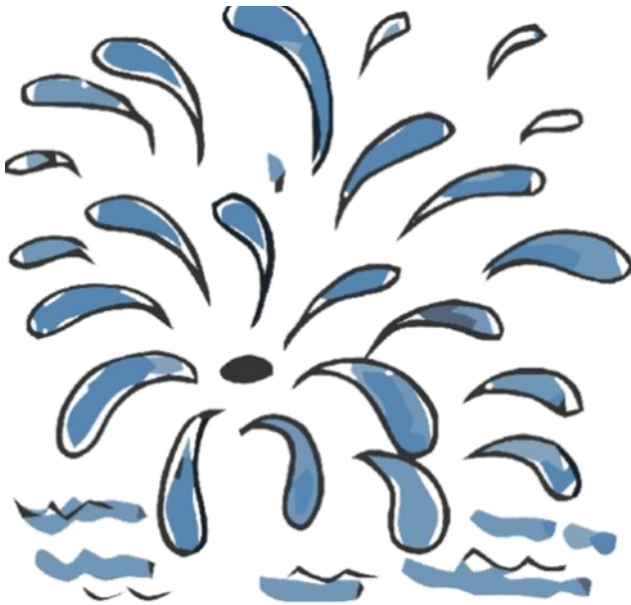


Sam gets onto the rocks and
