

We must rush, thinks Jack.


The bad men will soon be back.


Rush, rush, rush!

Jack looks at the feet.


This looks bad, Bill! I think we have a dragon in the woods!

Bill is glad he can not see the




Bad men sink the ship and then a dragon in the woods! This is NOT good!
