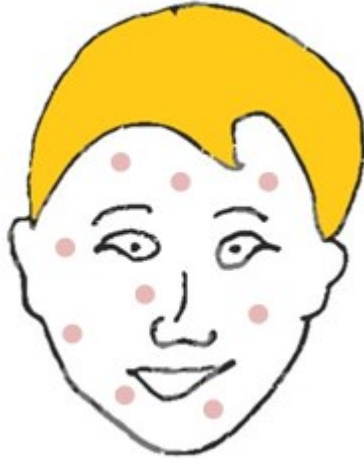
Have you ever had chickenpox? Chickenpox gives you lots of itchy spots. Sam has chicken pox!
