
Sam sweeps the yard.

He runs up to the pond to feed the ducks. He likes to feed the ducks. He has the food in a red bucket.


The ducks peck the food from the bucket. "Quack, quack, quack."



They run to peck the food.




Jiff likes to help on the farm too. He likes to think he is a sheep dog.
