inside

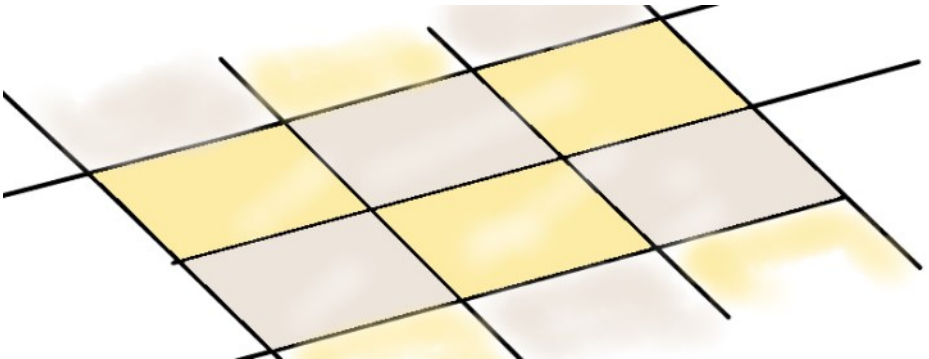
Then Gran has a think.
