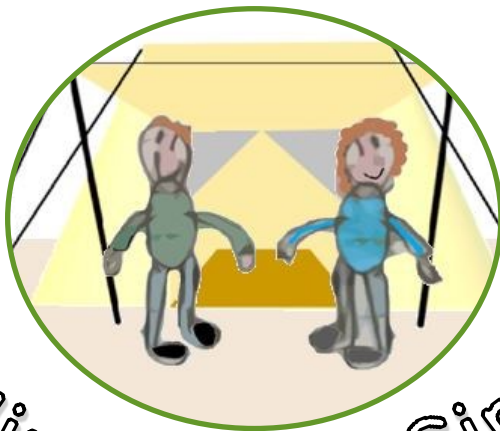

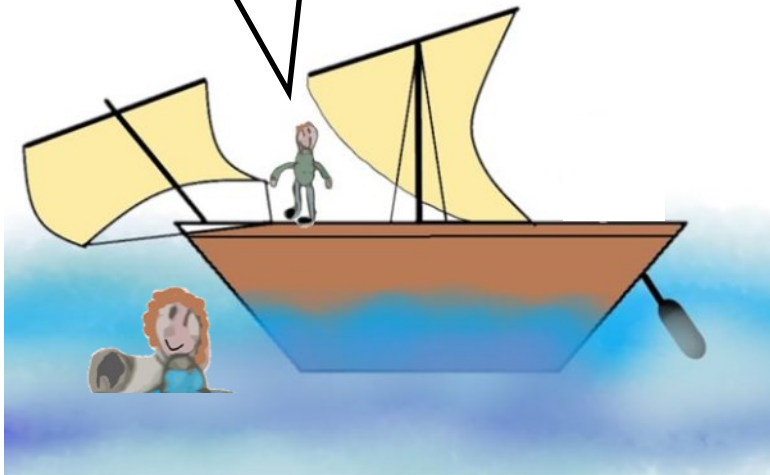

Jump on Bill.



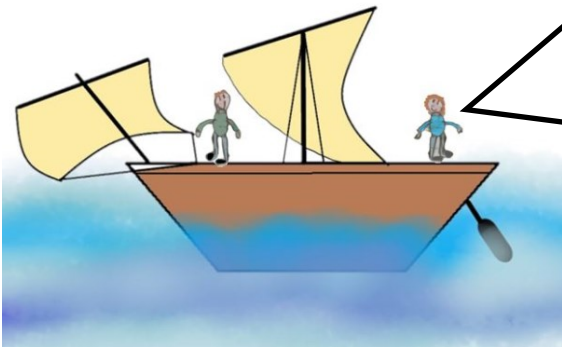
Jack gives

Bill can see the island.

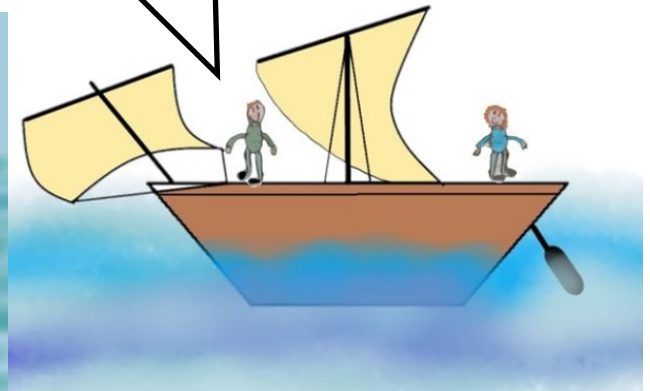
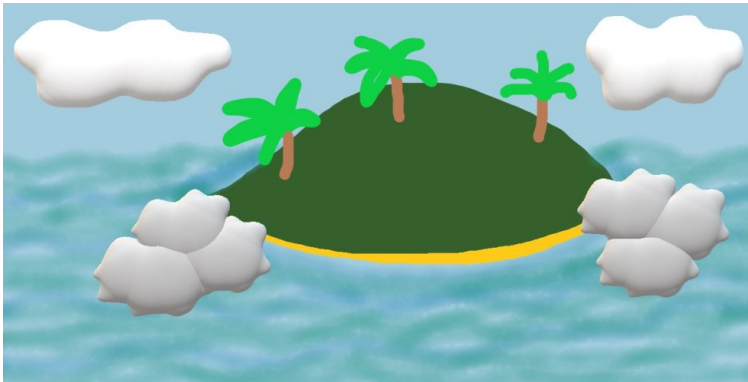


I can see the

Jack and Bill munch lunch. It is good to have fish in a dish on the sand.

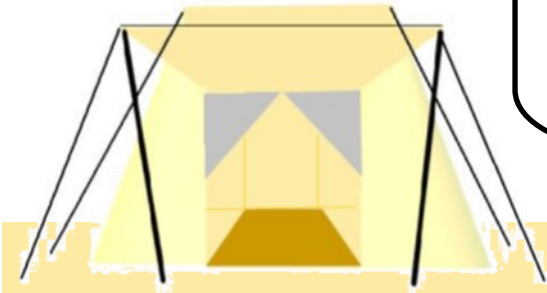
We can have a

Jack and Bill look at the tent.

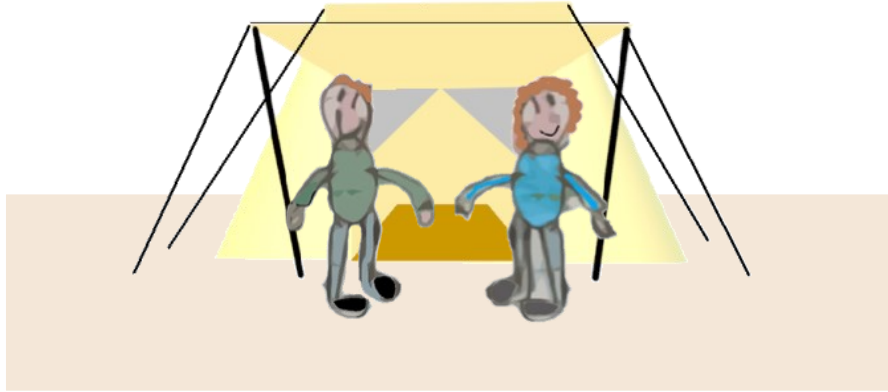
It is a good tent.
