Introduction:

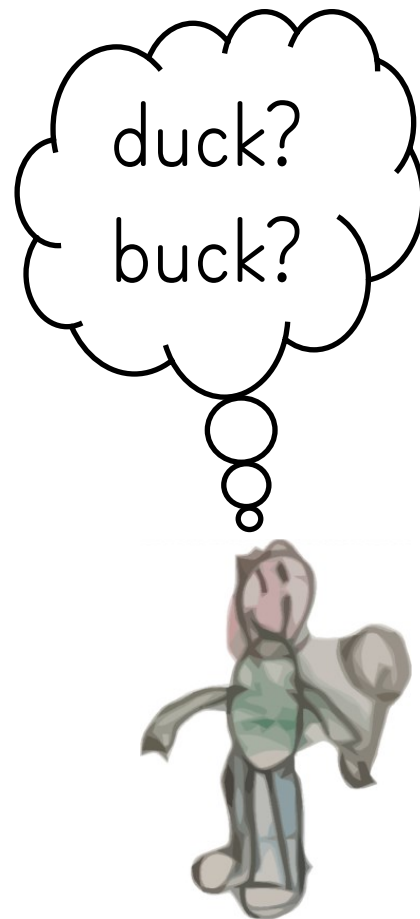
Jack needs food! He will go hunting. What can he find? Read and find out!

duck.

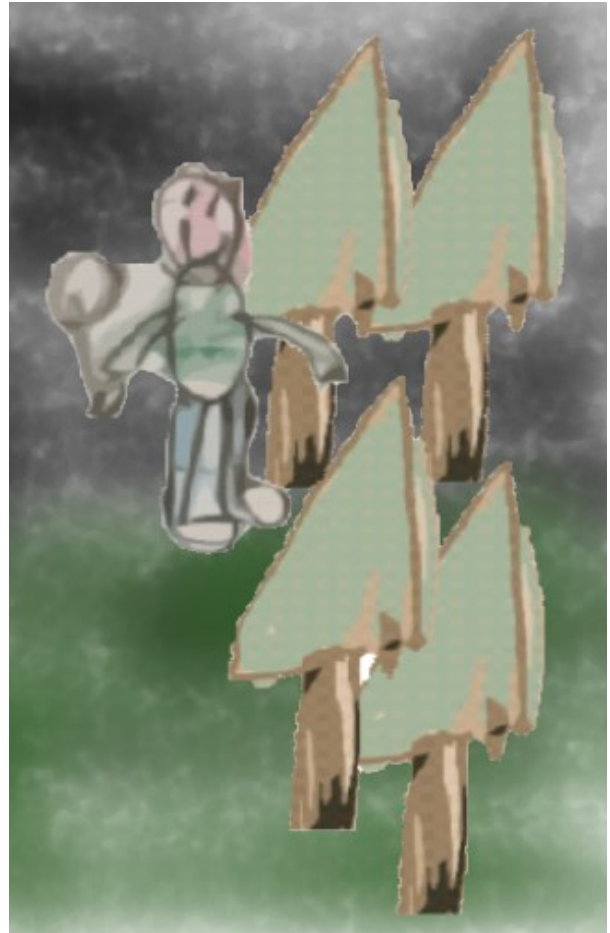
It is black.

The moon is not up.

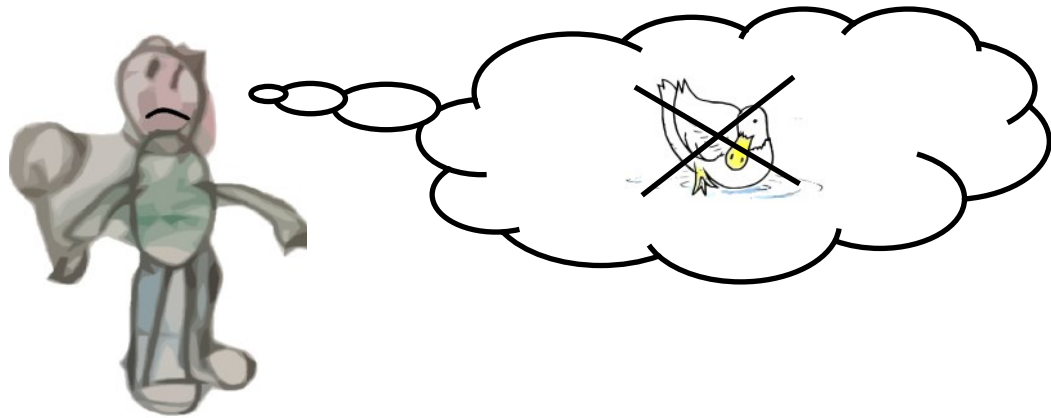


Jack runs and

duck?

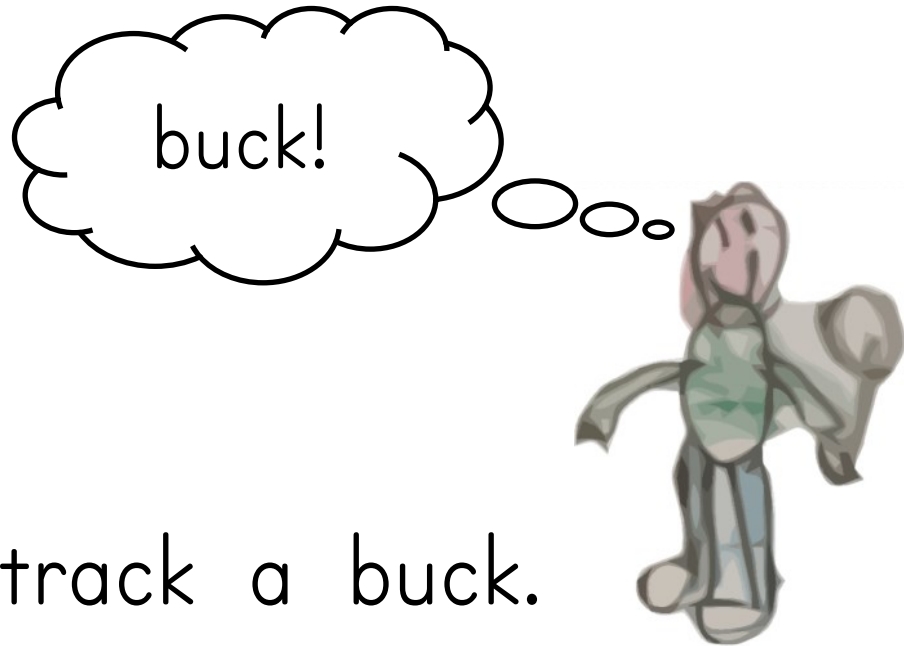


Jack is sad. He can not get a duck.
