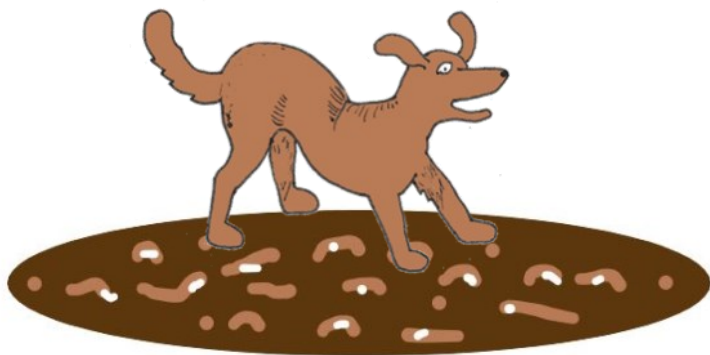
Tom gets to the woods.

Ted tugs and tugs. Soon the truck is free. Tom can go on up the hill to the sheep.

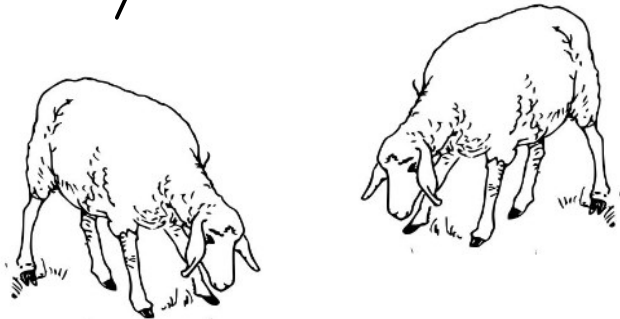


Tom is glad to see the sheep.
