Tom has a farm.

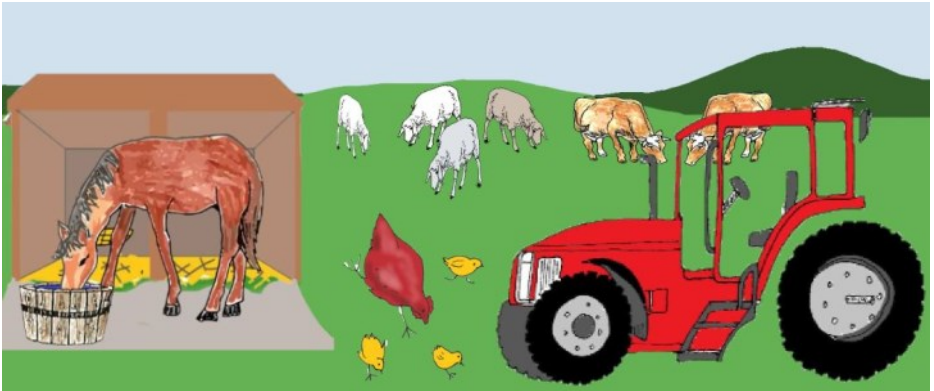
In the yard he has hens.

It is fun to go up the hill in the black truck.



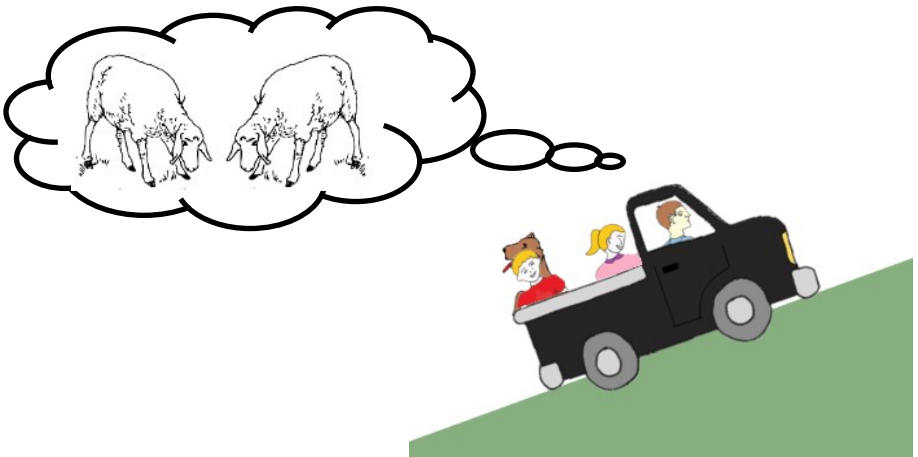
Tom feeds the sheep.
