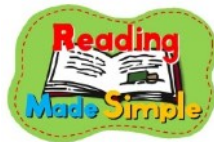

Hop, jump.

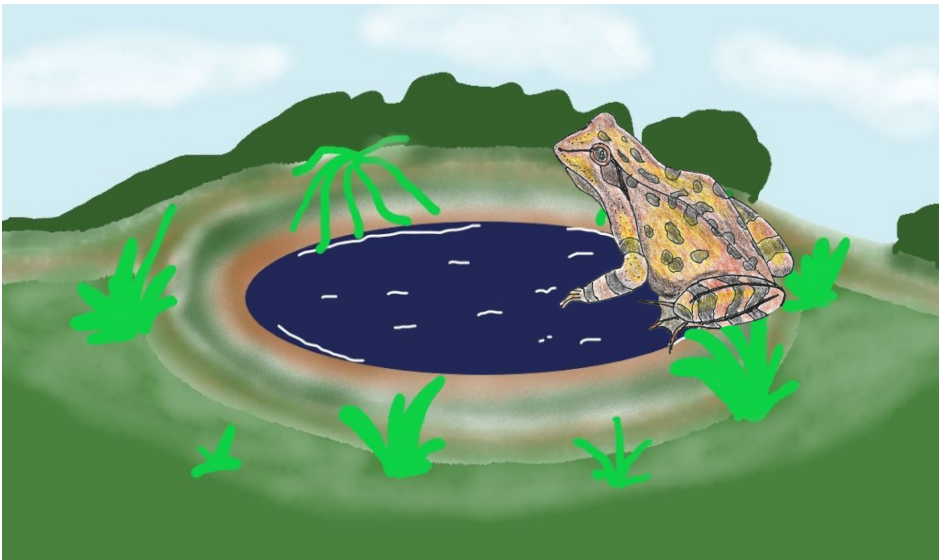
A slug.

jump into the pond.

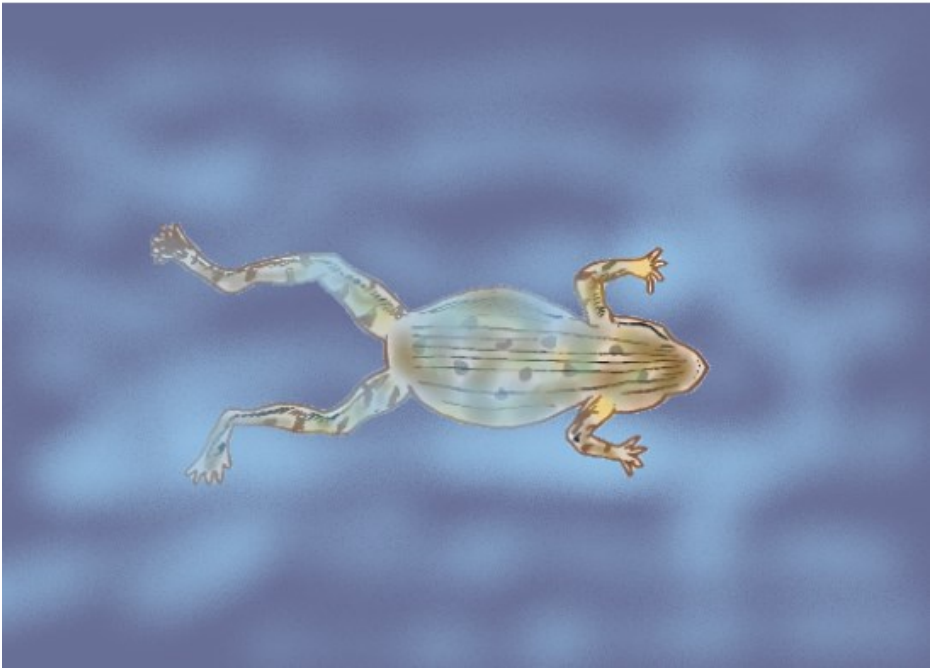
Glug, glug.
