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Jack will go to the woods to shoot rabbits.

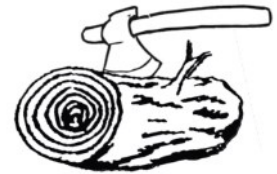
Jack got two rabbits.

He will cook the rabbits in his stick and mud hut.

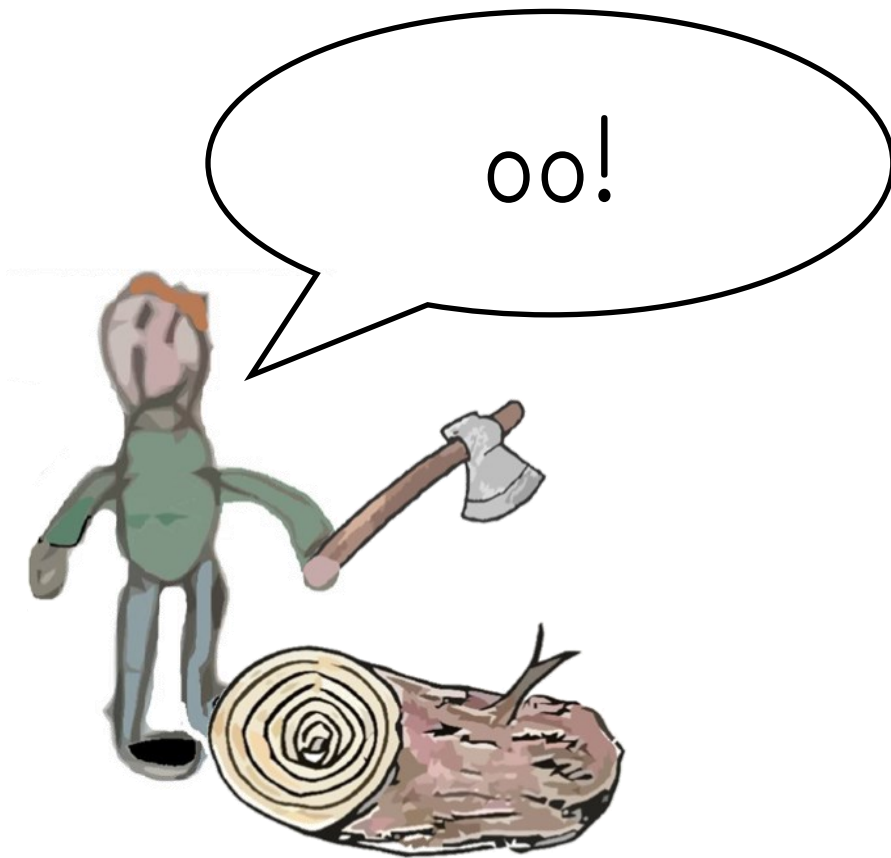
Jack will go back to the woods

Crash!



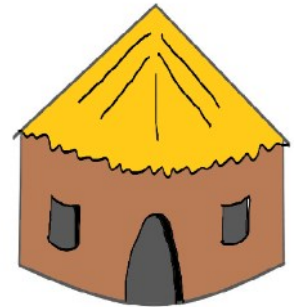
A big log fell on his foot.

Jack looks and looks.

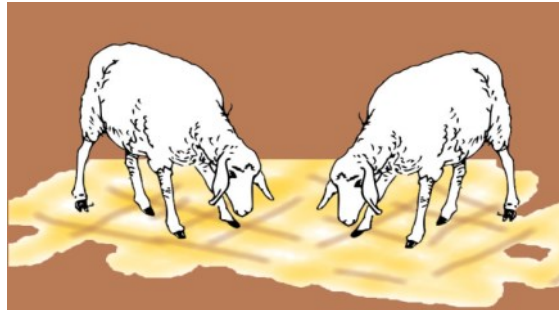
No big spoon.



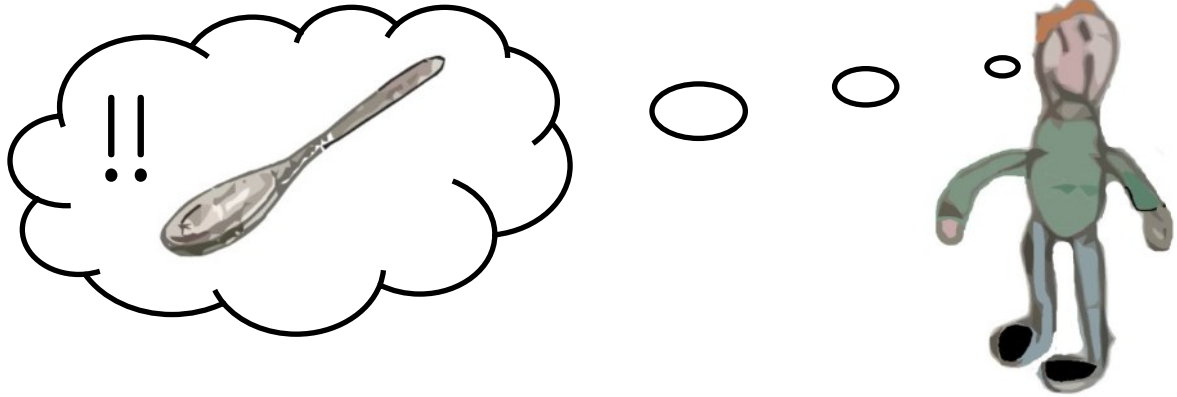
He looks on his bed.
