He brings it back to the floor.



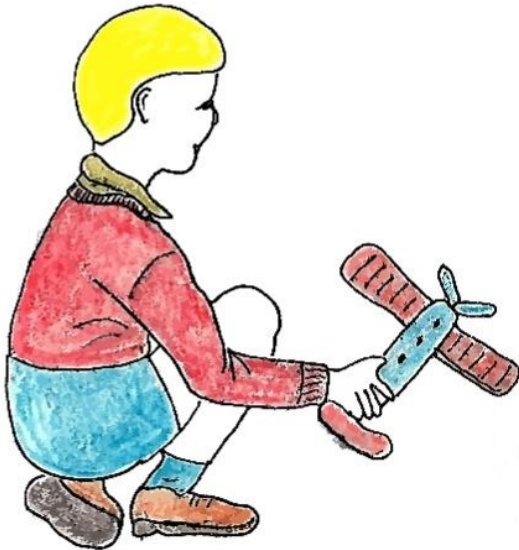
Sam makes up games with his plane.
