




## Introduction:

Frog can jump too!


Frog and rabbit have fun.

Hop, jump, hop, jump.


Rabbit meets two ducks.

Rabbit just looks at the ducks.




Rabbit meets a dog.


Can the dog run. Yes, he can.

The dog looks at the rabbit.




Rabbit meets a fox.

A big bad fox.


Will the fox have rabbit food?





The fox looks at the rabbit.






The rabbit must run.

Run, rabbit, run!




Fox runs too.


Is rabbit stuck?
