"I will go to the moon," he says.



"I will," said Sam.



"Jiff said bring him a bone," said Mum.




Sam waves and off he goes.

He looks up. It is dark.


He picks up some moon rock. He puts it in the rocket.

Mum and Dad run to see him.




"Did you get moon rock?" said Pam.
