tree!

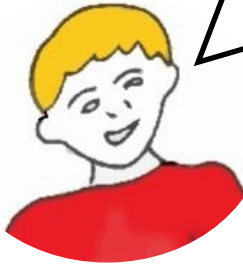
See them jump!

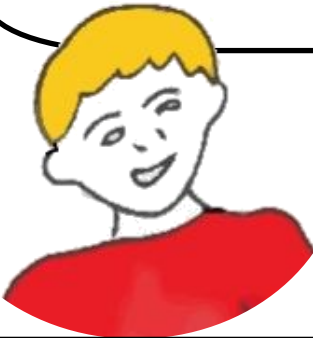
