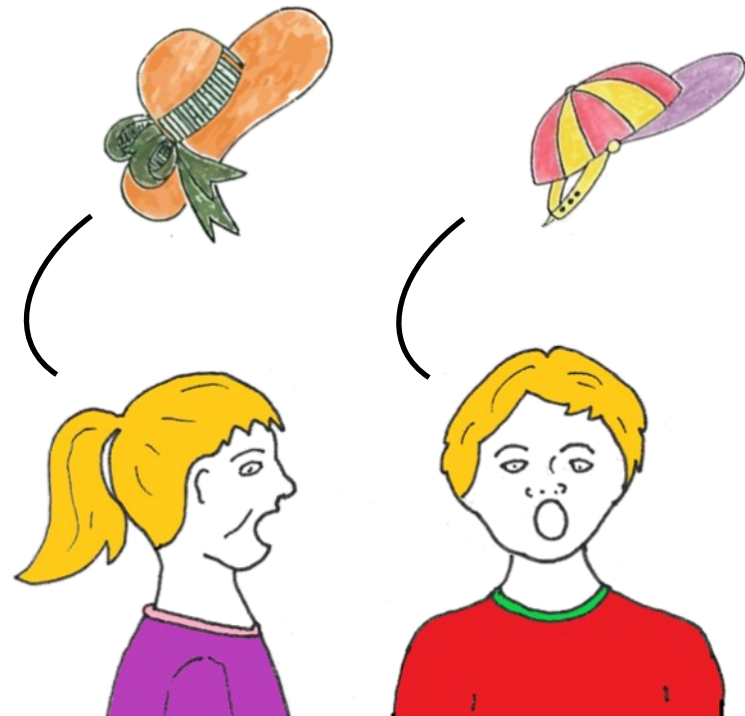
Introduction: What does the wind do? yes, it blows. Can you blow? Puff, puff. This story is about a windy day.
