chops chats such chest lunch munch


Jack is glad he lives in a stick and mud hut. I can see the hill top. I can see the green woods.

Jack chops and chops the logs.







Bill gives Jack a chest. He packs it on to the ship.


Jack gets his spoon and his dish.
