Read them three times.

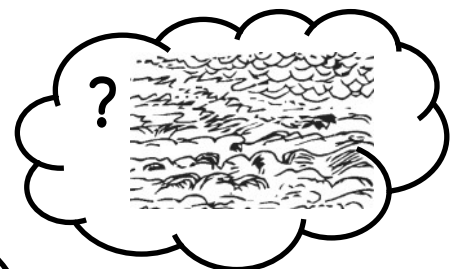

I can see the hill top. I can see the green woods.



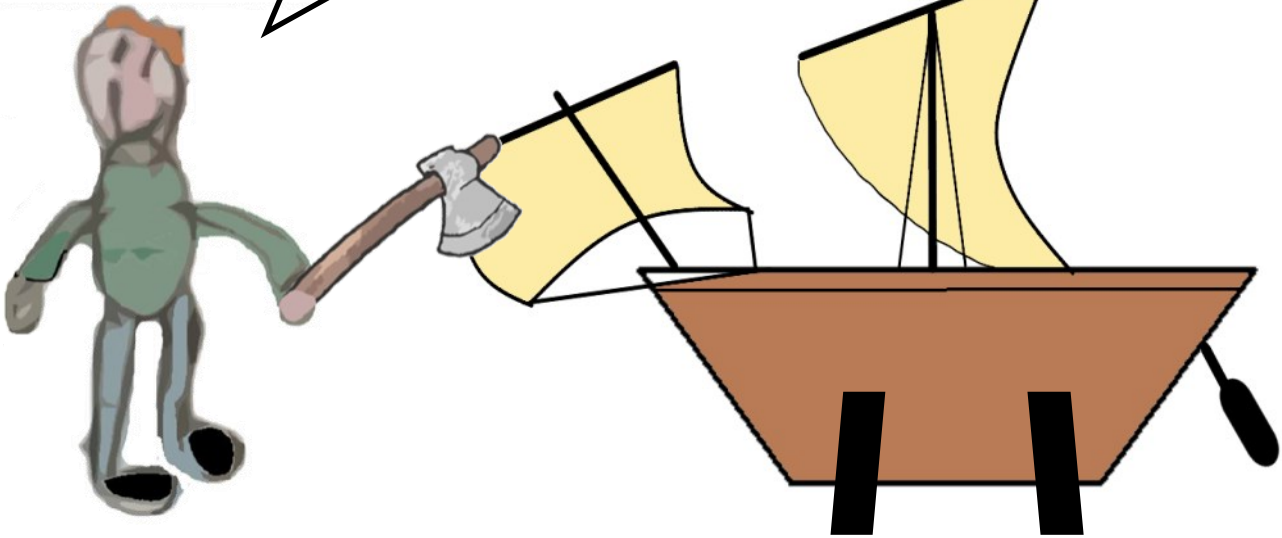
Jack chops logs in the big

Good!



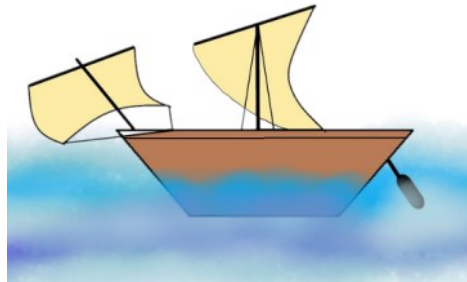
Jack is glad.

Bill will see Jack's ship.

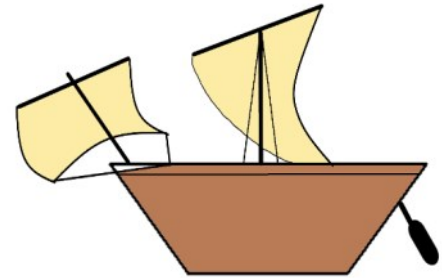
Jack has a  
good ship!



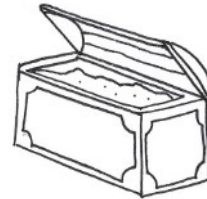


Bill gives Jack a chest. He  
packs it on to the ship.

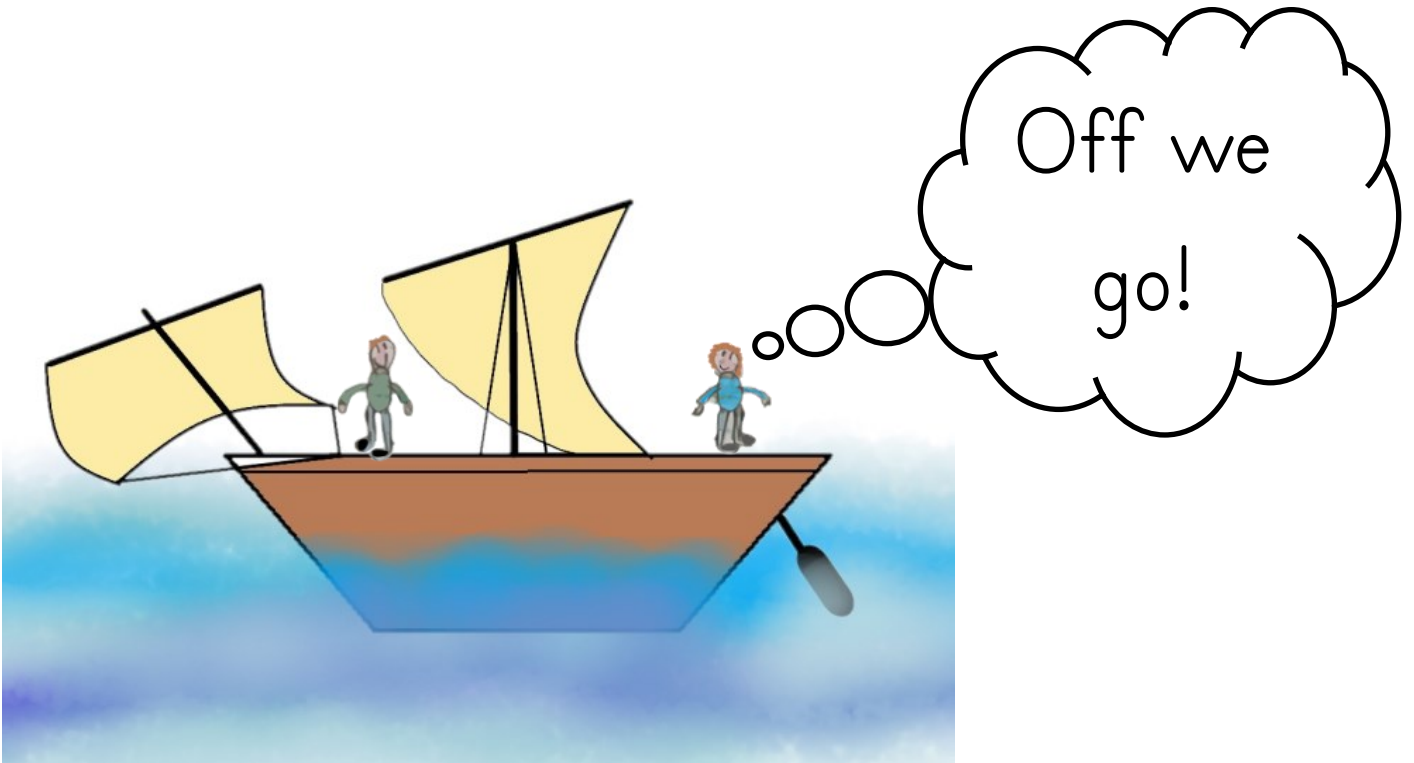
Jack gets his spoon  
and his dish.



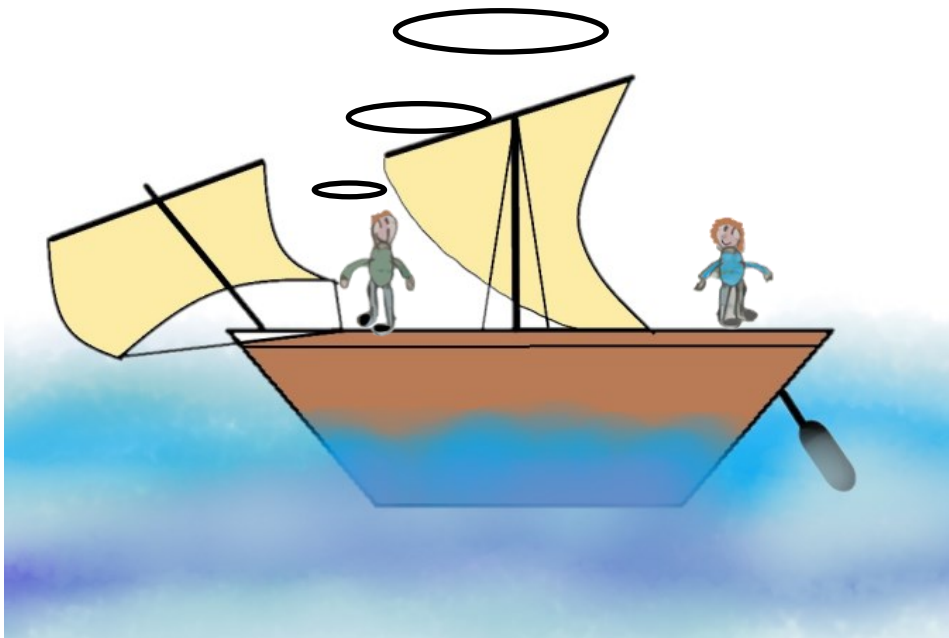
Bill and Jack get food.

Bill looks in the chest.

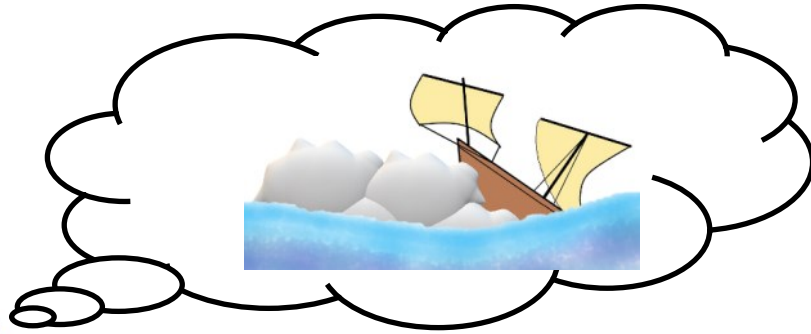
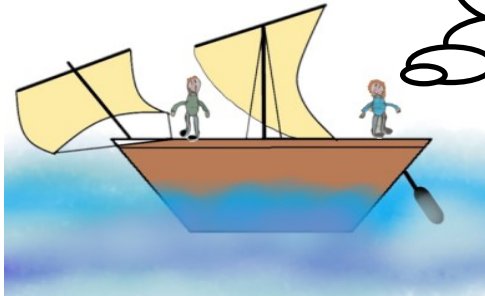
He gets two spoons.
