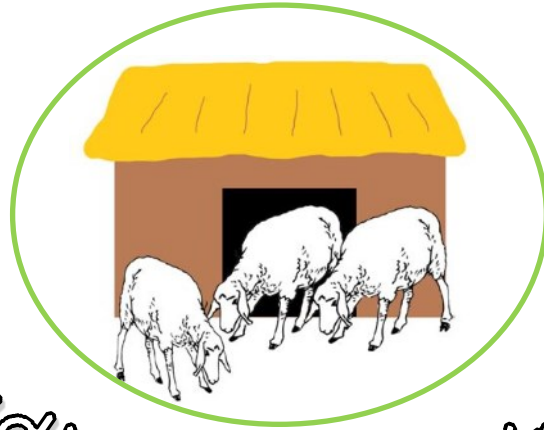

Jack is going to the woods to get lots of sticks. Bill is helping him. Bill feeds the dragon.

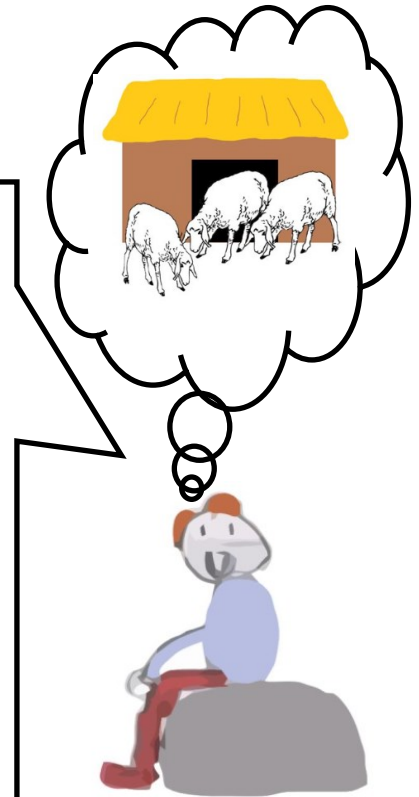
It is dark.
